Italian Cup and Cro-Ita-Slo Cup 2015

18 April 2015



MAP: scale 1:4000 contour interval 2.5 m, enlargement of a previous ISSOM map 1:5000, updated in 2015. A previous map without the last updates will be visible at the assembly area.

FORMULA: The competition is composed of two parts, qualification and final; in both parts there are 4 stations, each one with 4 tasks and 6 flags. All the competitors enter the final. The final will start as soon as possible, not waiting the results of the qualification. **Z (Zero) answer is possible**, when no flag is in the right position.

ZERO TOLERANCE The zero tolerance is 3m. Note for the beginners: this means that in case of a Zero flag, the flags are apart more than 3m from the correct position.

MODEL STATION

A model station is present at the assembly area. The maps are prepared like the ones in the competition.

START

The start of both parts is at the competition center. Free starts, max till 15:15 for the qualification. Control cards will be given at the first station of every part. The competitors are required not to bring a map of the place during the competition.

COMPETITION PATH

The path is reproduced in the rear of the control card. Signs will be present in the most important changes of direction.

PROCEDURE

In every station the competitor receives a bunch of 4 maps. The official will declaim the formula "6 flags, ALPHA – BRAVO – CHARLIE - DELTA - ECHO - FOXTROT– Time starts now!".

Only at this moment the competitor can open the bunch and solve the first question and the followings.

It is not possible to go to the next map before answering the previous, or go back to the previous map. Time limit for every station is **120 seconds**. 20sec before the term the official will warn the competitor saying "20 seconds!".

ANSWERS

Answers should be given verbally. If a competitor wants to give the answers pointing at letters, he should ask the official as soon as he arrives at the station. The answers must be given clearly using the English phonetic alphabet (Alpha, Bravo, Charlie, Delta, Echo, Foxtrot, Zero). The answers and the overall time are written on the control card. **We recommend the competitors to check the control card on coming out of the station: late complaints about mistakes in copying will be rejected.** After completing a station, the competitor goes on along the path till the STOP sign, and wait the call to the next station.

FINISH

At the competition center.

RESULTS

The times obtained in the 8 stations are summed with a penalty of **30 sec** for every wrong answer. Who obtains the least time wins.

PRIZES

Prize-giving about at 17:30. Prizes for the first three of each category, and for the best Paralympic..
